Column Generation 2012 will take place in Bromont, Quebec, Canada, a recreational city located in the beautiful Eastern Townships region, about 70 km east of Montreal. The workshop will start on Sunday, June 10, in the late afternoon with registration and a welcome dinner and will end in mid-afternoon on Wednesday, June 13. It is sponsored by the GERAD research center.

Like the successful Column Generation 2008 (Aussois, France), Column Generation 2012 aims at bringing together researchers from operations research, mathematical programming, and computer science which are active in solving large-scale integer programs via column generation. The workshop reflects the state-of-the-art of theory, applications, and implementation. It is informal in character and meant as a place of active research and exchange.
