

Google Operations Research: Student Engagement Opportunities for Summer 2023

A limited number of summer internship positions are available at Google Research in the area of Mathematical Optimization, working with teams in the Cambridge, New York, and Mountain View offices. Some projects may lead to an academic publication. Applicants must:

- have a background in Operations Research or a closely related field;
- be enrolled in a Ph.D. program;
- be prepared to participate in software development.

The internship is planned for 2023; start dates are flexible based on a candidate's availability. A minimum of 12 weeks full-time is required. Working onsite at a Google office is typically preferred.

We ask applicants interested in interning specifically with Operations Research teams at Google to do **both** of the following:

- Apply through the official channel:
 - If you are graduating after December 2024, we encourage you to apply to the [Student Researcher Program](#).
 - If you are graduating before December 2024, and are interested in potential full-time opportunities after you graduate, we encourage you to apply to the [Research Internship](#).
- Include in your resume that you are either pursuing a degree in Operations Research or that you have an interest in Operations Research.

Applications will be processed on a rolling basis. Once your application is reviewed, and if our screening team feels that you meet the qualifications for the role, you will receive more information on next steps from our recruiting team.
